### CONDITIONS FOR GRANT OF LICENCE

#### PRIVATE SECURITY AGENCIES (REGULATION) ACT - 2005 & KARNATAKA PRIVATE SECURITY AGENCIES RULES - 2008

1. The Licencee, employees & all security guards of the Private Security Agency shall undergo such training as is prescribed in the Private Security Agencies (Regulation) Act, 2005 and Karnataka Private Security Agencies Rules, 2008, Within a period of 6 months from obtaining this licence, failing which the same shall be revoked.
2. The licencee shall intimate the name, parentage, date of birth, permanent address, address for correspondence and the principal profession of each person forming the agency within fifteen days of receipt of the licence to the Controlling Authority.
3. The licencee shall inform the Controlling Authority regarding any change in the address of persons forming the Agency, change of management, etc. within seven days of such change.
4. The licencee shall immediately intimate to the Controlling Authority about any criminal matter/case/charge against the persons forming the agency or against any employee or private security guard or supervisor engaged or employed by the agency. A copy of such communication shall also be sent to the officer in charge of the police station where the person charged against resides.
5. The licencee shall provide any relevant information related to the Private Security Agency without any delay, as may be called for by the Controlling Authority from time to time.
6. Every licencee shall abide by the requirement of physical standards for the private security guards and their training as prescribed in these rules as the condition on which the licence is granted.
7. Save as provided in these rules, the fees paid for the grant of licence shall be non-refundable.

8. Issuance is subject to payment of such maintenance fee (on becoming so payable by the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka in writ petition No: 11895/2016) from the date of imposition of such levy.
9. The licence is issued subject to compliance to all the provisions of the acts mentioned in the schedule as per 13(1)(j) of PSARA 2005.
